1. EVENT TITLE, DATE & VENUE

- 1.1 Event Title: **CUE ENDURO SUPER SERIES CHAMPIONSHIP**- Club
1.2 Date: **SATURDAY NIGHT 30TH APRIL 2022**
1.3 Venue: Sydney Motor Sport Park, Ferrers Road, Eastern Creek NSW – the 3.9 km Gardner (GP) Circuit will be used.

2. ORGANISATION AND STATUS

- 2.1 The Event shall be held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, the National Competition Rules of Motorsport Australia, the Circuit Race Standing Regulations, these Supplementary Regulations and any Further Regulations and instructions to Competitors that may be issued.
2.2 The Event shall be a **Club NIGHT** race meeting, with races for the invited vehicles as listed in **7.** below.
2.3 This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with Motorsport Australia OH&S, Motorsport Australia Safety 1st and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the Motorsport Australia website at;

4. MEDICAL

Will be operating per Motorsport Australia MEDICAL SERVICES/REQUIREMENTS-Medical Services at Motor Sport Events-3.1.4.3 Alternative for Club, Multi-Club or State Championship Race Meetings.

5. CIRCUIT DETAILS

- a) Length: 3.9 km
b) Direction: Anti - Clockwise
Track Density: The maximum number of starters permitted in any race will be in accordance with Motorsport Australia guidelines. For Production Sports Cars (47) vehicles.

6. ENTRIES

- a) Entry Fee for this event will be \$1690 (incl)
- b) Entries shall be accepted in order of receipt.
- c) The Organiser reserves the right to refuse entry to any Competitor in accordance with the NCR.

7. EVENT FORMAT

- a) There will be 2 x 5min compulsory **fuel** pitstops during the race
- b) Races will be conducted for vehicles complying with Regulations for **Production Sports Cars** as outlined in the 2022 Motorsport Australia Manual and will be a **300klm Endurance Race**.
- c) There will be a minimum of 1 and a maximum of 2 drivers.
- d) 1x 20min Qualifying Sessions for DRIVER A
- e) 1 x 20min **Qualifying** Sessions for DRIVER B
- f) For single driver teams, Driver may participate in both Qualifying sessions.
- g) Pro-Am Teams are eligible to enter.
- h) Pro drivers must not exceed more than the time/distance advised in the event FSR's. (Approx 40% of total distance).

8. REFUELLING IN PIT LANE

Refuelling in Pit Lane will be conducted under the **Motorsport Australia CIRCUIT RACE APPENDIX; REFUELLING IN PIT LANE PART 2 - REFUELLING IN PIT LANE AT A CLUB/MULTI-CLUB/STATE COMPETITION**

9. CHEQUERED FLAG

The Chequered Flag will be shown to the lead vehicle at the designated Finish Line on their first pass after the completion of the 300klm.

10. LICENCE & MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

- 10.1 Competitors must hold a current Motorsport Australia-Affiliated Car Club Membership unless they comply with 8.2.1 or 8.2.2 below.
- 10.2 Each Driver must hold a minimum of a Motorsport Australia Circuit Licence with provisional endorsement, unless noted otherwise against a particular Event or specified otherwise in the Sporting Regulations for the relevant category Championship/Series or;
 - 10.2.1 Hold a Motor Sport New Zealand competition licence and valid Tasman Visa for the event or
 - 10.2.2 Hold the minimum of the highest-grade National Licence issued by a foreign ASN required for the Event and obtain approval to compete from the ASN that issued their licence. Each such Driver and Competitor:
 - 10.2.3 Will be ineligible to score points in a Championship/Cup/Series/Trophy etc. connected with the Event: and
 - 10.2.4 Shall be required to receive an authorisation to compete from Motorsport Australia prior to the Event

9. AWARDS/PRIZES

Awards for this Event will be as follows;

- i. Round trophies will be issued based on the Natsoft or other official timing system results for the final race of the weekend.
- ii. Classes for Round Trophies will be based off the fastest lap time for the vehicle during all official sessions of the event (qualifying and race sessions).
- iii. Any vehicles deemed ineligible for Championship points will be ineligible to win a round trophy.
- iv. Trophies will be presented for first, second and third place in all classes, assuming there are vehicles eligible to fill each of these places.
- v. The Association, depending upon availability and sponsor requirements, may award sponsor prizes at individual rounds and/or for the overall Championship winners

10. AUTOMATIC TIMING

The Organisers utilise an automatic timing system that requires all cars to be fitted with a Data 1 transmitter. Competitors must provide the transmitter. Transmitters are available from Dorian Industries, Factory 1, 29 Graham Court, Hoppers Crossing VIC, 3029. Phone: + 61 3 9931 1371.

12. GARAGE AND PADDOCK ALLOCATION

Garages and Carport allocations for this event will be by consultation with the PSCRAA.

13. CREDENTIALS

- 13.1 All Competitors will be emailed their tickets for the event (10).
- 13.2 There will be Tender car passes issued for this event.
- 13.3 All Competitors should enter Sydney Motor Sport Park via Gate AA, (just prior to Gate A) off Ferrers Road.
- 13.4 All Event Admin/Scrutineering will be done at the AMAROO BUILDING. Times to be advised in Further Regulations. Proceed through Gate A and down to the Tunnel Entrance where admit passes will be checked. Then continue to your chosen/available spot in the North Paddock.
- 13.5 Pit Lane wristband passes will be issued to Pit Crew at this point also.
- 13.6 If you need to withdraw your entry you must advise the ARDC in writing no later than 1700hrs on Monday 24th APRIL 2022. The ARDC will not consider refunds unless this requirement is strictly adhered to. A \$50.00 administration fee will be charged for ALL withdrawals

14. TARGETED SCRUTINY

Scrutiny at this event will be undertaken under the Motorsport Australia Targeted Scrutiny process, and the Motorsport Australia **RETURN TO RACE** Scrutiny of Vehicles and Apparel documents.

The Self Scrutiny Confirmation of Vehicle Compliance will be emailed to all competitors prior to the event as an electronic waiver. This must be completed and **SUBMITTED PRIOR TO THE EVENT**.

All Competitors must wear apparel in compliance with Schedule D of the Motorsport Australia Manual. All footwear, socks and gloves must comply with FIA 8856-2000 standard.

15. FUEL

Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.

Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any other Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day. The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol by a Motorsport Australia Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy at www.motorsport.org.au.
